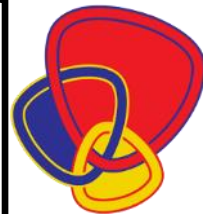


The Monega Messenger

READY FOR SCHOOL

Please be reminded that school starts at **8:30am** and finishes at **3:00pm**.

We expect all pupils to arrive promptly at 8:30am. Any pupils arriving after this time will receive a late mark. It is important that pupils attend school everyday unless the child is unwell. Afternoon gates will close at 3:10pm.

Any children not collected on time will need to be collected via the School Office.

BREAKFAST CLUB

Breakfast Club is **£1** per child per day from **8:00am** - **8:30am**

It is important that children establish a good routine of preparing for school the night before.

We want to help to prepare our young learners to be responsible individuals.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AND FINES

By law, if your child is aged 5 to 17 years old, they must be in full-time education and attending school everyday unless the child is sick.

REQUESTING HOLIDAY LEAVE

The school will **NOT AUTHORISE** any holidays during school time. If you do, you could receive a penalty notice.

The law changed in September 2013 and schools no longer have the freedom to allow parents to take their children out of school for up to ten days in term time.

PENALTY NOTICES AND FINES

If you take your child out of school without permission, you may receive a penalty notice. If you receive a penalty notice you will have to pay:

- £60 per parent for each child - if you pay within 21 days.
- £120 per parent for each child - if you do not pay within 21 days, but do pay within 28 days. If you do not pay, you will be taken to court.
