PENALTY NOTICES AND FINES

Penalty fines for taking your child out of school will result in parents being fined the following:

- £60 per parent for each child if you pay within the 21 days
- £120 per parent for each child if you do not pay within the 21 days, but do pay within the 28 days. You may also face court action if not paid on time.

Since the change in law, schools no longer have the freedom to authorise or allow parents to take their children out of school for up to ten days during term time.
