It was a privilege to welcome Philippa Stobbs from the Department of Education (DfE) to Monega. Philippa's professional background is in teaching and social inspection work. Working with the Council for Disabled Children (CDC), Philippa has nationally recognised expertise and, until her recent retirement, led the education work at CDC. She continues to work with CDC, the Anti-Bullying Alliance, the Information Advice and Support Services Network and with the DfE as an independent educational consultant.

During the visit, Philippa observed assemblies, walked the classrooms, spoke to pupils and looked at children's outcomes.

Phillipa was impressed by everything she saw and thought that Monega was a very special place.

In 2022, Philippa won the nasen (National Association for Special Educational Needs) Person of the Year award. In addition, in 2023, she was awarded an OBE for Services to Disabled Children.
